Adella Chavez appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. There were no concerns from the City or the Police Department. The Authority approved the license renewal. The application will be mailed to the Department of Revenue for issuance of the license.

CORPORATE REPORT OF CHANGES

Colorado KSR, Inc. d/b/a Liquor Max Warehouse 1497 East Eisenhower Blvd.

Kathryn Rogers appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. The Authority clarified that the corporation was not transferrring ownership, just shifting the way the stock is being held to a Trustee. The Authority approved the corporate report of changes conditinally upon receipt of satisfactory background reports. The application will be sent to the Department of Revenue for State approval.

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP

Eclipz Salon, Inc. d/b/a Charlie L's Pub 271 14th Street SE

The applicant has applied to transfer ownership from Gray Family Ventures LLC to Eclipz Salon, Inc. A temporary transfer permit was issued October 12, 2012. Julie Baumann appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. Ms. Baumann and all the staff attended the December training class for alcohol service. There were no concerns from the City or Police Department. The Authority approved the application conditionally upon receipt of satisfactory background reports. The application will be sent to the Department of Revenue for issuance of the license.

Turner Limited d/b/a Studio Vino 426 North Lincoln Avenue

The applicant has applied to transfer ownership from PM Ventures LLC to Turner Limited. A temporary transfer permit was issued November 1, 2012. Sara Turner appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. Ms. Turner described her experience in the business and will attend the next alcohol server training class in March. Ms. Ablao mentioned an incident at Studio Vino where alcohol was being taken outside the building. Ms. Turner explained that the air conditioner quit and the patrons stepped outside to cool off. It was a one time occurrence and would not happen again. The Authority approved the application based upon receipt of satisfactory background reports. The application will be sent to the Department of Revenue for issuance of the license.

4. SHOW CAUSE HEARING

Local Licensing Authority December 20, 2012

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the suspension or revocation of said license for alleged violations by the Licensee; or by any of the agents, servants, or employees of said Licensee, of the provisions of the Colorado Liquor Code, or of any of the rules or regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

Dillon Companies, Inc. d/b/a King Soopers #74 1275 Eagle Drive 3.2% Off-Premises Retail Beer License Renewal & Manager Registration November 10, 2012 to November 10, 2013

Attorney Robert Dill appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. The Authority read the procedures to be followed into the record. The Authority disclosed a possible personal conflict with King Soopers. Mr. Dill did not perceive it as a concern and agreed to go forward with the matter. Ms. Ablao stated that a stipulation had been agreed upon whereby the Licensee would voluntarily and knowingly admit to violating C.R.S. 12-47-301(8) by failing to register a manager within 30 days on or about May 23, 2012. The Authority accepted the Licensee's admission of the violation and waiver of the right to a hearing. In considering the eligibility for a fine in lieu of suspension, the Authority agreed that King Soopers #74 is eligible because the license is held in the name of the store and not the company name. The City recommended and the Authority imposed a 3 day suspension. All 3 days shall be served by a fine in lieu of active suspension. A fine of \$200 was imposed and is due by December 31, 2012. The Authority signed the Order which will be sent to the Licensee. The renewal and manager registration was approved conditionally upon receipt of satisfactory background reports. An appearance at the next renewal of the license will be required by the Licensee.

5. OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS

The Authority clarified that after a thorough review of the procedures for obtaining CBI/FBI background reports, approving the applications conditionally based upon satisfactory receipt of the background reports on the applicants was acceptable to the City Attroney and LLA Secretary. If a discrepancy is found, the applicant will be noticed to appear to address the issue before the Authority.

The next regularly scheduled Local Licensing Authority meeting will be January 17, 2013 at 8:30 a.m.

Having no further business to come before the Authority, the meeting was adjourned at 8:59 A.M.
