2.  **Scenario - Response**

- Damage reports are still coming in from the field.
- Significant Damage is reported to life, property and the environment.

Walk through your process at the local level.

- If an Emergency Operations Center is established, where would it be?

5.  **Scenario Continued...**

- Reports are coming in regarding destroyed buildings with people trapped
- Major power outages are reported throughout the area
- Roads and bridges are blocked by debris hindering the emergency response effort
- The 911 Communications Center is overloaded with calls for assistance

- Some county and municipal buildings have been damaged hindering government operations
- Many responders have been affected personally, either through damaged/destroyed
