Substantial Public Purpose

- 2. Highlighting Loveland's arts community.
- 3. Sales of art.
- 4. Downtown businesses experienced significant sales increases during these events.

Some additional Considerations

- Request EL Events/Engaging Loveland to dissolve and "wind up" the entity in accordance with Colorado law.
