3. <u>DEVELOPMENT SERVICES</u> (presenter: Noreen Smyth) MILLENNIUM NORTHWEST FOURTH SUBDIVISION UTILITY EASEMENT VACATION

A Motion to Approve and Order Published on Second Reading an Ordinance Vacating a Portion of a Utility Easement within Tract B and Outlot E of the Millennium Northwest Fourth Subdivision, City of Loveland, County of Larimer, State of Colorado

This is a legislative action to consider adoption of an ordinance on second reading vacating a portion of a utility easement within the recently approved Millennium Northwest Fourth Subdivision (the "Fourth Plat") also known as The Lakes. The easement, which was created by separate document in 2006, was replaced with a new utility easement with the recordation of the Fourth Plat. The vacation of a portion of the older easement that does not align with the new easement and the overlapping portion is now requested in advance of the approval of the Millennium Northwest Fifth Subdivision (the "Fifth Plat"). The Fifth Plat will establish single family residential lots where the unused easement is currently located. The applicant is McWhinney Enterprises. This ordinance was approved unanimously on first reading by Council at the October 7, 2014 regular meeting.

4. <u>DEVELOPMENT SERVICES</u> (presenter: Brian Burson) MOUNTAIN PACIFIC GDP REZONING TO ALLOW MIXED USE

A Motion to Approve and Order Published on Second Reading an Ordinance Amending Section 18.04.040 of the Loveland Municipal Code, the Same Related to Zoning Regulations for Certain Property Located in the Mountain Pacific Addition, City of Loveland, Larimer County, Colorado

This is a quasi-judicial action to consider an ordinance, on second reading, rezoning portions of the Mountain Pacific Addition as "Mountain Pacific Business Park PUD", and approving the General Development Plan for development of the property. The property was originally developed under Larimer County jurisdiction for enclosed storage. The property is located at the southeast corner of North Garfield Avenue (Highway 287) and East 71st Street, consisting of approximately 20.09 acres. The proposal would allow additional development for such uses as retail, office, banks, personal service, institutional, educational, assembly/light industrial uses, and enclosed storage. This ordinance was approved unanimously on first reading by Council at the October 7, 2014 regular meeting.

A Motion to Approve and Order Published on First Reading an Ordinance Enacting a Supplemental Budget and Appropriation to the 2014 City of Loveland Budget for the City of Loveland's Share of a Regional Tax Increment Financing Study

This is an administrative action. The ordinance appropriates funding for the City's share of the costs (\$30,000) of a regional study on the use of tax increment financing with the County in the future. The study will be managed by Larimer County, with funding contributions from the county and all the cities. The ordinance is funded with unassigned fund balance within the General Fund reducing the flexibility to fund other projects. If the ordinance is approved there will be \$10,443,670 remaining fund balance.

VALUE PLASTICS, INC. INCENTIVE AGREEMENT AND SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION

These are administrative actions. The amendment and appropriation for \$255,330 from the Economic Incentive Fund would be used to cover the additional cost of water and sewer line infrastructure and additional water and sewer tap fees. The original agreement was approved by Council on October 1, 2013. The cost increase was shared by Nordson Corp/Value Plastics whose cost to construct increased by \$3.2 million since the approval of the incentive agreement. The amended incentive package will add \$255,330 to the incentive, bringing the total amended incentive package for Value Plastics to \$849,066.

LINCOLN HOTEL APARTMENTS APPEAL

Appeal Regarding Fire Code Violations at Lincoln Hotel Apartments

This is a quasi-judicial hearing on two outstanding fire code violations (basement storage of combustible materials and lack of code-compliant exits) at the Lincoln Hotel Apartments, 365 North Lincoln Avenue, found during a fire inspection conducted on October 9, 2013. On November 19, 2013, the Fire Marshal issued an Order to Correct the violations. The property owner appealed the Fire Marshal's Order, first, to the Fire Chief and then to the Fire Rescue Advisory Commission ("FRAC"). Both the Fire Chief and the FRAC upheld the Order. The matter is now before Council on appeal as provided in the Loveland Municipal Code ("LMC").
