Caroline Gill appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. The Authority commented that the Good Standing Certificate had been obtained by the Licensee in order to be able to renew the license; however, it was the second late filing of the renewal submitted before the expiration date of the license but after the 45 day deadline before expiration. Ms. Ablao stated that because of the eight days being held in abeyance from the violation this year by the Licensee, a formal warning letter would be issued and placed in the file. Ms. Gill understood the action and stated that there would be no further problems. There were no other concerns by the City or the Police Department. The Authority approved the renewal of the license.


#### 4. OLD BUSINESS/NEW BUSINESS

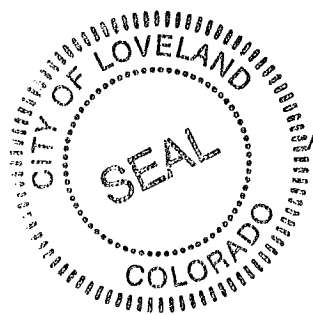
Ms. Weaver addressed the Authority on two matters from last month's renewals that the State was unable to issue licenses on until the Licensee submits additional information. The request for Rock Bottom Restaurant and Brewery was to provide a manager registration form, although the statute doesn't require it, but in order to update the State's file with the current manager. City Clerk, Terry Andrews came forward to address the Authority about lengthy discussion with the State Liquor Enforcement Division at the CMCA/GFOA Conference on manager registrations. The State's position on registration is that it is used as a way to insure managers aren't listed on more than one establishment; however, Ms. Andrews said they may remove the requirement altogether after hearing the Clerks' position. In this case, the Secretary obtained the completed form from the corporate office. The Authority reviewed the file regarding prior action for manager registrations with Rock Bottom Brewery and signed the application as requested. The State's second request concerned the renewal for Dorothy's Catering due to a conflict with the entity name and account number. The State requested the Licensee to submit a transfer of ownership application to update the file, but without charging the associated fees, due to the State's error. Ms. Ablao voiced concern that the State's request may not leave the choice up to the Licensee. The Authority stated that the application would be signed administratively if the Licensee complies with the request.

#### 5. ADJOURNMENT


