PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS seventy-three years ago this week, on December 7, 1941, the surprise

attack of the Imperial Japanese Naval Forces against the United States 7th Fleet at Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, occurred, marking the entry of America into

World War II, altering the course of history forever and

WHEREAS the Congress of the United States has designated December 7 as National

Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day (36 U.S. C. §129) to honor all who

perished at Pearl Harbor; and

WHEREAS twenty three of Colorado's sons, including Loveland's own Harold Dwayne

Webster, United States Navy Seaman Second Class, were killed in Action on December 7, 1941 while serving on the battleship USS Arizona at Pearl

Harbor, Territory of Hawaii, and

WHEREAS Americans owe a debt of gratitude to all who died while courageously

defending Pearl Harbor as well as to all who survived and fought with valor and spirited determination so that freedom would not fall to tyranny,

ultimately achieving victory,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of Loveland, do hereby proclaim the week of December 7 through December 13, 2014 as

in Loveland, Colorado, and in so doing, urge all citizens to join together in remembering and honoring all who perished at Pearl Harbor that fateful day as well as all our World War II Veterans.
