- Citywide Revenue
 - > \$82.8 million, excluding transfers
 - > 1.9% above budget projections
- Citywide Expenditures
 - > \$78.7 million, excluding transfers
 - > 47.3% below budget projections
- Citywide revenues exceed expenditures by \$4.1 million.



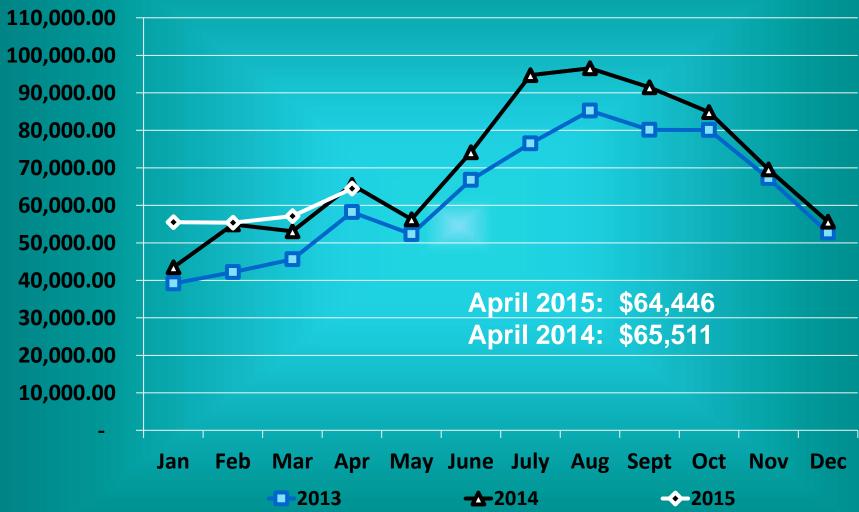
- General Fund Revenue
 - > \$28.8 million YTD, excluding transfers
 - 2.5% above YTD Budget
 - 0.1% below same period last year
 - Sales and Use Tax Revenue
 - > \$15.6 million YTD
 - .6% above budget projections
 - ▶ 6.7% above same period as last year
 - Sales Tax only
 - > \$13.8 million YTD
 - > 1.5% below budget projections
 - 4.1% above same period last year



- General Fund Expenditures
 - > \$23.6 million YTD, excluding transfers
 - > 21.4% below budget projections
- General Fund Revenues Exceed Expenditures by \$3.9 million
- > Health Claims
 - > April Claims \$1.0 million
 - > 2015 YTD decreased from \$4.0 mil to \$3.9 mil from same time as last year (2.5%)







► Lodging tax YTD is \$232,463 (7.1% higher than 2014 YTD).
