3. REGULAR AGENDA – PUBLIC HEARINGS (Appearance Required)

NEW LICENSES

- a. 5th Street Bar LLC dba Captains Bar & Restaurant
111 East 5th Street

The matter was continued from the May meeting. The applicant amended the application from a Tavern license to a Hotel and Restaurant license as requested by the Authority. Timothy Lee did not appear, however, an emailed request from Mr. Lee was received by the Secretary asking for withdrawal of the application from consideration by the Authority. The Authority affirmed the withdrawal of the application and ordered the license fee to be returned.

- b. The Noodle Shop, Co.-Colorado, Inc. dba Noodles & Company
225 East 29th Street, Ste. 103

The application was filed for a new Hotel and Restaurant license. The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires. The Authority read the procedures for the Public Hearing. The neighborhood boundaries were identified as: N-43rd Street; S-Eisenhower Blvd.; E-Madison Avenue; and W-Taft Avenue. The Secretary's files were admitted into the record. Mr. Junglas' opening statement revealed that the business is still under construction, however, upon issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy, the City has no objection to the issuance of the license. Corporate Attorney Kim DeLuca was sworn in to testify about the alcohol server training program provided for employees. Area Manager Jennifer Anderson was sworn in to testify about the operation of the business, control of the patio area and alcohol service in the restaurant. Tina Scott of Oedipus, Inc. was sworn in to testify about the performance of the survey of the neighborhood. The results showed 98% of those surveyed favored the issuance of the license. The City recommended conditional approval of the license issuance upon completion of construction, issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy, and completing the required inspection of the premises by the Police Department. Ms. DeLuca requested issuance of the license. The Authority reviewed the evidence and after hearing the testimony, asked if there were any other parties in interest present. Hearing none, the Authority closed the Public Hearing and made the following findings: The adult inhabitants of the neighborhood desire the issuance of the license; the reasonable requirements of the neighborhood do not preclude the issuance of the license; and the applicant is qualified to conduct the type of business proposed. The Authority conditionally approved the issuance of the new license upon completion of the construction, issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy and obtaining the final inspection of the premises by the Police Department.
