WHAT'S IN A PLANT'S NAME?



SPECIES

A group of plants that share a common gene pool and can freely interbreed. The species is always binomal (two words): Genus + Specific Epithet

GENUS

A group of species that share common traits

FAMILY

A group of plants in related genera that share common reproductive traits

COMMON NAME

Local name given to a plant. Some plants have many names

SPECIFIC EPITHET

Word combines with a genus name to define a species

Plains Cottonwood

Populus sargentii 'occidentalis'

Salicaceae (willow)
North America (Great Plains)



MEHAFFEY PARK
ARBORETUM

CULTIVAR

A refined selection of a species or hybrid

-PLANT ORIGIN

Native range of the species. Garden Origin means it originated by human selection / hybridization
