**4. SHOW CAUSE HEARINGS**

Thomas Dunn, Attorney for the Licensee, appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. The Authority accepted the Stipulation and signed an Order as follows below:

The purpose of the hearing was to consider the suspension or revocation of said license for alleged violations by the Licensee; or by any of the agents, servants, or employees of said Licensee, of the provisions of the Colorado Liquor Code, or any of the rules or regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

The Licensee shall serve a suspension of 20 days of its Hotel and Restaurant License; 10 days of suspension shall be held in abeyance for one year. The remaining 10 days shall be served as a fine of \$1,565.00 in lieu of suspension to be paid within 90 days and alcohol server training is required within 120 days for employees that haven't been trained in the last two years.

**6. STAFF REPORT**


Mr. Junglas thanked staff for the meeting held regarding SB16-197 effective on July 1, 2016, and discussion on the impacts to our processes.
