3. **REGULAR AGENDA** – (Appearance Required)

TEMPORARY MODIFICATION OF PREMISES - PUBLIC HEARING

ACTION TAKEN: The Authority approved the temporary modification of premises conditionally upon submittal of an amended diagram detailing the parking lot area's additional fencing and control plan for prohibiting alcohol to leave or be taken into that area.

a. Dream Machines Events Inc.4270 Byrd Drive

The application was filed for a temporary modification of premises to extend the current 1.4 acre premises by adding the parking lot areas to the licensed premises totaling 11.56 acres or 503,554 s.f. to hold numerous events (list available in the City Clerk's Office) from December 3, 2016 through September 30, 2017. The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires.

4. STAFF REPORT

The Secretary shared several issues of concern with the Authority. After discussion among the group it was decided as follows: Delinquent Occupational Tax is being addressed by the Sales Tax Division; the Fee Schedule should be updated after the update of the State Fee Schedule; and an update of the LLA's Rules of Procedures will be scheduled in February. The City Clerk came forward to speak and prompted discussion regarding the DDA/LDP's request to pursue a Common Consumption Area in Loveland; impartial interpreter usage; and consistent procedures for scheduling the interpreter at the end of the meeting and not allowing the Licensee to arrange for their own interpreter. Officer Mayoral spoke about the recent compliance checks that were done. Out of 40 establishments checked, there was only one violation. The Authority acknowledged that the Liquor Enforcement Unit has done a tremendous job with educating the Licensees in the class and commended the Unit for their efforts.
