### 4. **STAFF REPORT**

The Secretary distributed copies of the year-end update of the Cost Analysis for 2016 prepared to line up with the calendar year and for budget purposes. A comparison chart from the SB16-197 Statutory Working Group on Malt Liquor vs. Fermented Malt Beverage and the three types of retail licenses affected was also distributed as information for staff. City Clerk, Terry Andrews, came forward to address the group about the cost analysis and pointed out that the number of show cause hearings has dropped significantly over the last several years and that it is directly attributed to the education offered by the Police Department and the Authority's support to endorse their efforts. Ms. Andrews also spoke about the Secretary's goal to train the team in Innoprise Licensing reviews to help meet the expected growth of liquor licenses within the City due to recent development activity.
