SHOW CAUSE HEARINGS

ACTION TAKEN: Authority approved stipulations as follows below:

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the suspension or revocation of said license for alleged violations by the Licensee; or by any of the agents, servants, or employees of said Licensee, of the provisions of the Colorado Liquor Code, or any of the rules or regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

Show Cause Hearing and Tavern License Renewal

Kathleen Primiano appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. A stipulation was approved whereby the Licensee will serve a suspension of 40 days of its Tavern License; 5 days shall be actively served and 20 days of the suspension shall be held in abeyance for one year. Fifteen days of the suspension will be served by a fine in lieu of suspension totaling \$1,050 to be paid by February 1, 2017.

Attorney Kevin Coates appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. A stipulation was approved whereby the Licensee will serve a suspension of 8 days of its Tavern License; 4 days shall be held in abeyance for one year; and 4 days shall be served by fine in lieu of suspension totaling \$200 to be paid by February 1, 2017.
