### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**City Council Update (Daryle Klassen)** Process continues to search for the best applicant for the City Manager's position.

Daryle requests input from this board regarding (MM) Medical Marijuana. The city council is discussing a few options. One is to decree to put the dispensaries to a VOTE, Opt OUT of a decision, or wait for the State Legislature to draw out rules. Currently there are 13 dispensaries located in Loveland. Sales tax revenue is \$38,000 to date. Council has extended moratorium on new dispensaries through Dec. 3, 2010.

Vice chairman asked for a straw vote; This Advisory Board is in favor of putting MM on the ballot in November.

**Senior Networking Event (Phoebe Hawley)** This year, it was necessary to increase registration fee to \$20, as this is a self sustaining event.
