Crossroad Holdings LLC dba The Boot Grill a. 124 East 4th Street

ACTION TAKEN: Attorney Adam Stapen and Mike Zapf appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. A stipulation was approved whereby the Licensee will serve a suspension of three (4) days of the Hotel and Restaurant License; the four days will be served as a fine in lieu of active suspension. The Licensee shall pay a fine totaling \$2,408.00 in lieu of the suspension and the fine will be paid on or before January 1, 2018.

4. PUBLIC HEARING – (Posting and Publication required)

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP & MODIFICATION OF PREMISES

AKA Kitchen Inc. dba AKA Kitchen a. 414 East 6th Street

Action Taken: The applicant did not appear to answer questions. The matter was continued to the regular meeting on January 18, 2018.

The application was filed for a transfer of ownership of the Hotel and Restaurant License from Adelita's Inc. A temporary transfer permit was issued on October 12, 2017. A Modification of Premises application was also filed for remodeling the interior of the restaurant. The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires.

NEW LICENSES

a. Miss Daisy's BBQ & Blues LLC dba Miss Daisy's BBQ & Blues 129 East 5th Street

ACTION TAKEN: Clay Caldwell appeared to address the Authority and answer questions. There were no parties in interest appearing. The Authority held the Public Hearing and approved the license upon completion of the final Building, Fire and Police Department inspections.

The application was filed for a new Hotel and Restaurant License to dispense malt, vinous and spirituous beverages by the drink for consumption on the premises. The neighborhood boundaries were designated as: North - Eisenhower Blvd; South - 14th St. S.W./Hwy 402; East - Madison Avenue; and West - Taft Avenue. The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires.
