- Compiled summer pitch sheet to tell various stories about summer travel in Loveland. Story ideas will continue to be added/pitched to work to secure opportunities.

























Dark Heart Coffee Bar Finally Lights Up in Loveland, Colorado

Even for experienced builders, a new coffee shop will never go exactly according to plan. The unexpected will come in many forms, and at times some buildout hurdles may prove too high to leap.

For Allison and Justin Real, who were working on a space in Loveland, Colorado, to bring their dream of a multiroaster cafe called Dark Heart Coffee Bar to life, one major electrical hurdle led to an even larger hurdle: a stubborn landlord.

Roughly one full year and \$100,000 into the buildout of a space on 5th Street in the small mountain city, the pair needed to contract some electrical work, which is one of only a couple areas the Reals couldn't handle on their own. The electrician encountered some issues, and a month before the projected opening day, city inspectors confirmed that none of the existing electrical work was permitted or up to code, according to the Reals.

"The owner was upset when we compelled him with a letter from our attorney to bring his building to code, and responded with an eviction notice," Justin Real told Daily Coffee News. "We were even going to pay for the electrical upgrade. All he had to do was submit for a new permit to upgrade electric. He refused."

As tensions mounted and the path ahead proved costly and insurmountable, the Reals ultimately took their attorney's advice and moved on, operating a mobile coffee and kombucha cart along the way. A year and a half later, the couple — which has also been building out restaurants, bars, coffee shops, casinos and hotels for over a decade through their custom design and fabrication company Real Industrial Edge Furniture — have finally realized their vision.

"My favorite thing to do is fabricate industrial materials in a slightly more modern way, and this was our opportunity to build out our dream space," said Real, who crafted Dark Heart Coffee with a modern industrial feel. "Our goal was to pull together a beautiful creative space with intention in every detail — 'an exceptional beverage in an engaging atmosphere."

Within the 1,200-square-foot space with a 400-square-foot enclosed patio, the Reals provided and helped install the structural steel for the renovation. They finished the bar in zinc and created every accent, including a hand-torched shou sugi ban accent wall. Allison Real hand-troweled lime and mica walls accented with gold leaf and filled existing concrete cracks with gold acrylic. They built their own reclaimed wood tables and steel frames, fabricated brass wall sconces and steel pendant lamps, and more.

Equal attention has been paid to the coffee, which is run through either a Mahlkonig K30 of EK43 for extraction on either a two-group Mavam under-counter espresso system or Fetco batch brew. A pair of Baratza Fortes grind for pourover executed via Fellow Stagg EKG and Fellow drippers. The coffee program is anchored by beans from Portland's Coava Coffee Roasters. Said Justin Real, "We chose Coava because we believe in their commitment and pursuit of quality."

Offerings from other small-batch roasting companies are rotated roughly monthly and are featured mainly as drips or pourovers, and on espresso only occasionally. Said Real, "When we choose a roaster to highlight, we research them to see what their standards are — [to see] if they're passionate and genuine humans, and to see if their standards match ours."

Dark Heart also offers an array of drinks on tap, including two locally made nitro cold brews and five kombuchas, the latter of which, when considered alongside nine more kombuchas in bottles, amounts to what Real said is the largest kombucha selection in Northern Colorado.

Local craft beer and biodynamic wine are also on offer, although it's the coffee that courses most fervently through the veins of these perseverant entrepreneurs — hence the dark heart.

"Someone may want to just get their coffee and leave with zero chitchat, or someone may want to know every detail about our Mavam. We try and cater to every person's individual needs," said Real. "The customers who truly search for quality coffee and an overall amazing experience are who we want to engage."





Verboten Brewing in 'Brewery Madness' finals

Downtown Loveland brewery faces off against Greeley's WeldWerks in people's choice


A Loveland beer "team" has charged its way through the March Madness brackets and now is facing a Greeley brewery in the finals.

Verboten Brewing found itself as the only Loveland brewery on Colorado Brewery List's "sweet sixteen" of small breweries in the Colorado Brewery Madness competition, based on the votes of fellow brewers.

"We're totally thrilled and honored that they would pick us as one of the top 16," said Angie Grenz, co-owner and marketing director for Verboten. She said the brewers considered both the beer and the taproom experience when voting for their favorites.

"It's nice that they recognized us as a place they enjoy coming and hanging out and having a beer," she said.

The downtown brewery then won three rounds against other breweries, gaining votes from the public on the Colorado Brewery List website, coloradobrewerylist.com.

Verboten is stepping up its game.

The first couple of rounds, Grenz put posts on the brewery's Facebook page about the competition. She said the Verboten crew pushed a little harder for the third round, against Centennial's Resolute Brewing Co., asking visitors in its taproom at 127 E. Fifth St. to vote

"This one's going to be the toughest one yet," Grenz said Tuesday. "WeldWerks is very popular, and they do a beautiful job at what

they do. We anticipate we'll have an uphill battle."

Added Verboten co-owner Jason Bowser: "It's a friendly competition."

On Monday afternoon, Grenz sent an email to people across Loveland, asking for their support.

"We're soliciting our fans and friends to vote for us," she said. "Now it's down to Loveland getting recognition as the top-voted small Colorado brewery.

"It's an opportunity for the community to speak for us," she said. "We think that Loveland's pretty special, and we'd like Loveland to be known for the quality of its craft beer as much as anything

Verboten knocked off Denver's Baere Brewing in the first round and Elevation Beer Co. in Poncha Springs in the second.

Late Tuesday afternoon, the voting was running 59 percent to 41 percent in Verboten's favor, but Grenz said WeldWerks has put on a spurt at the end in the earlier rounds.

Expanding capacity

Verboten opened in January 2013 in an industrial area of central Loveland and moved downtown in the spring of 2016.

Business has been growing downtown. Grenz said — so much so that Verboten has been contracting with Snowbank Brewing in Fort Collins for two years and Grimm Brothers Brewhouse in Loveland for eight months for use of their brewing systems to help it meet demand.

That problem is about to be solved, Grenz said, with the installation of a new 15-barrel brewhouse. Previously, head brewer and co-owner Josh Grenz was working with a three-barrel system.

"We went from being the smallest brewhouse in Loveland to now being the biggest brewhouse in Loveland," Angie Grenz said, although Grimm Brothers still has more fermentation capacity.

"In a week we can brew what we would brew in a month before," said Josh Grenz.

Angie Grenz said Verboten sells about 60 percent of its beer in its taproom, and the other 40 percent goes to bars, restaurants and liquor stores in kegs and 22-ounce bomber bottles.

The larger capacity will allow Verboten to extend its reach, she said, explaining that liquor stores are hesitant to devote shelf space to a brewery that can't guarantee it will provide a consistent supply of beer.

"We'll try to fill our pipeline in Northern Colorado and then expand our sales in the Denver and Boulder area," she said. "We are already down there, but we're pretty selective."

Grenz said Verboten kept its three-barrel brewing system so will be able to do small batches and experimental brews: "We call them weird beers."

The brewery also held onto one of its four-barrel fermenters, which it will use to make sour beers.

Crystal Creek Reservoir is an 140 acre lake in the central part of the state, 15 miles northwest of Colorado Springs.

Dillon Reservoir is a 3,500 acre body of water in the northcentral portion of the state, 70 miles west of Denver, nearby Silverthorne, CO.

Eleven Mile Reservoir is a 3,400-acre reservoir in the center of the state 10 miles west of Lake George, Colorado.

Grand Lake is a 600-acre lake located in the north-central portion of the state, at the southwestern corner of Rocky Mountain National Park, at Grand Lake, Colorado.

Green Mountain Reservoir is a 2,100 acre lake at an elevation above 7,900 feet. It is in northwest-central Colorado approximately 70 miles northwest of Denver.

Gross Reservoir, located 5 miles southwest of Boulder, is a 440 surface acre lake at an elevation of 7,225 feet. Accessible via Flagstaff Road from Boulder. CO.

Horsetooth Reservoir is a 1,900-acre lake in the far-north, central part of the state on the western outskirts of Fort Collins, Colorado.

Lake Granby is a 7,200-acre lake located in the north-central portion of the state, at the southwestern corner of Rocky Mountain National Park, 5 miles from Granby, Colorado.

Lake Isabel is a 40-acre trout lake at an elevation of 8,600 feet. The lake is located 35 miles southwest of Pueblo, and 18 miles northwest of Colorado City.

Lake San Cristobal, located 50 miles south-southwest of Gunnison, CO, is a 330 acre lake (the second largest natural lake in Colorado), it is 20 miles due east of Ouray, as the crow flies.

Lathrop State Park is 3 miles due west of the town of Walensburg, Colorado in the south-central portion of the state. Lake Meriam and Lake Oehm are located within the park.

McPhee Reservoir is a 4,500-acre lake located in the southwest corner of the state, due north of Delores, Colorado.

Morrow Point Reservoir, located on the Gunnison River, at Cimarron, CO, is an 800 acre lake at an elevation of 7,160 feet.

Navajo Reservoir is a 15,000-acre lake located on the Colorado - New Mexico border mid way between Durango, Colorado and Pagosa Springs, Colorado.

Rampart Reservoir is a 500 surface acre lake 4 miles east of Woodland Park, CO (as the crow flies). Access to the lake is via Rampart Range Road.

Ridgway Reservoir, located a dozen miles north of Ouray, CO, can exceed 1,000 surface acres when full.

Ruedi Reservoir, a 1,200-acre lake, is 35 miles southeast of Glenwood Springs, at Meredith, CO.

Shadow Mountain Lake is a 1,300-acre reservoir located in the north-central portion of the state southwest of Rocky Mountain National Park, at Granby, Colorado.

Sloan Lake, located in the northwest section of Denver, is a 177 acre recreation lake within Sloan's Lake Park.

Stagecoach Reservoir is an 800-acre lake in the northwest section of Colorado, 20 miles south of Steamboat.

Standley Lake is a 1,000-acre lake in the north-central part of Colorado at Westminster, just northwest of Denver.

Taylor Park Reservoir, located 15 miles northeast of Gunnison, CO is a 2,000 surface acre lake

Williams Fork Reservoir is a 1,600-acre lake located in the north-central portion of the state 2 miles southwest of Parshall, Colorado.

Wolford Mountain Reservoir is a 1,550 acre lake in the Rocky Mountains, located in the northwest part of the state 30 miles west of Grandby, Colorado.





Crow Hop's mantra states that "It's About the Beer!" which is evident in their eight flagship beers (yes, eight), accompanied by roughly eight more rotating taps. Sleeping Owl is one of the staples; an oatmeal stout that is strong and robust, with a touch of coffee to wake up your taste buds. This bad boy is nice and dark, and I highly recommend this as your go-to nightcap.





Rob Duguay: This current tour Roots Of Creation is on is named after the album of the same name that's being released on March 9. The album has the band performing renditions of Grateful Dead songs, so how did the idea for the concept come to be?

Brett Wilson: I started way back in the day learning how to play guitar; this had to be around 20 years ago. Grateful Dead's catalog is ingrained in my brain from around that time.

When I play solo acoustic I usually play a Dead cover here and there just for fun. We did a Halloween show where we covered all Grateful Dead songs in a reggae rock style and that was where the idea was born when we did that for our friends at Jerry Jam.

It's kind of an organic thing and we linked up with Errol Brown who engineered and produced Bob Marley's last three albums in various capacities.

We thought that it was the perfect project to do with him because he can get all of those awesome tones and the mixing right. He let us take the songs that we've always loved and flip the script. From what I've heard so far, people have really enjoyed the way we did it in a live setting. It ended up turning into an awesome record with a lot of collaborations. We're really excited to share it with everybody.

RD: Where was it recorded?

Wilson: It was recorded in Brookline, New Hampshire, which is my hometown, at Studio Metronome. I actually got my start interning there when I was really young making coffee, cleaning the bathrooms and working my way up.

RD: You mentioned doing collaborations on the album, which includes the likes of Stephen Marley & G. Love. What was it like working with them? Did you consider a learning experience?

Wilson: With G. Love, I started jamming with him and we became friends during Slightly Stoopid's event Closer To The Sun in Mexico a couple years ago. We had some sushi and some drinks and we really hit it off. The following year he invited me back for a G. Love and friends session and we had a lot of fun and we kept in touch.

Our good friend John Phillips kind of started the process of linking us up for a studio collaboration and he laid down some harmonica on "Ripple" which was really cool.

Melvin Seals, who was Jerry Garcia's organ player, is part of that track too so it was pretty dope to have him on there with G and we became good friends.

Stephen Marley graciously invited us to his Kaya Fest in April that's happening in San Bernardino, California. ...
We were working with him and his production company and Stephen did it for the love of it. He loved the music and the vibe and the idea behind the project. We were just happy that he embraced it the way he did.

RD: The band used the crowdfunding site PledgeMusic to raise funds for the making of Grateful Dub. We live in an age where artists are using outlets like these to get fans involved in the making of their work, so how do you feel it worked out for the band this time around and does Roots Of Creation plan on using PledgeMusic in the future?

Tal Pearson: The way that it worked out for the band was really great because it allowed us to stay in contact with all of our fans throughout the process. From the announcement of the fact that we were doing it, to progress reports and status updates. We got to show different inside feeds and parts of the production process that normally wouldn't be involved in making a record.

The fans felt more connected to the whole process and it made it a lot more fun for us due to us interacting with fans instead of being held up in a studio worrying about whether it's good or not. We hit our goal and hopefully the fans are happy with it because I'm happy with it.

Wilson: We dropped an entire live set of these songs that we did with Melvin Seals and a bunch of special guests at Jerry Jam and nobody else but people who contributed to the campaign got that.

We have an alternate version of "Standing On The Moon" that we weren't sure if we wanted to put out the full band version or the solo acoustic version so we ended up just putting out both. We wanted to give our fans as many awesome things as possible as a big thank you for being a part of making the album.


They're putting so much faith towards this because they're purchasing something that doesn't exist yet. It's awesome that people believe in us to that extent.

RD: After the tour, what's next for Roots Of Creation?

Pearson: We have tons of festivals planned. As Brett mentioned, we're doing Kaya Fest. We're going to be at the Arise Music Festival in Loveland, Colorado in August with Slightly Stoopid, Thievery Corporation and I think Pepper is playing that. Hopefully we'll have some more touring in the summer and definitely in the fall

Wilson: We're going to do a month long trek out to the west coast, then through Colorado and into the Midwest. We'll also be playing with The Wailers at Mt. Snow in West Dover, Vermont on March 24 and it's a free show.







As Women of Aviation Week begins this week, the country with the highest ratio of female airline pilots may come as a surprise to some. India has the most female pilots per capita as a little more than 12 percent of Indian airline pilots are women. Finland is neck and neck with India but most other countries are far behind that total. In the U.S. it's 5.1 percent and worldwide just 5 percent. India was relatively late to the game in hiring females for the flight deck but its airline industry is also fairly new. The first female FO started working in 1984.



Meanwhile, Women of Aviation Week attempts to boost those numbers by giving girls and women firsthand contact with the aviation industry and women who work in it. The belief is that the relative scarcity of female role models has led to the belief that flying is not a riable career option as girls start mapping out their working lives. Many WOAW events are ouilt around Fly It Forward events in which volunteer pilots take girls and women for their first flight in a small plane. One of the largest of hundreds of events planned for this week will be in Loveland, Colorado.




