The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires.

ACTION TAKEN: Utumporn Originales appeared to address the Authority and answer questions, Tele-Language was utilized for Thai interpretation. There were no parties in interest appearing. The Authority was satisfied that the applicant is qualified to hold a liquor license and was approved, conditionally upon completion of the final Police Department inspection.
