A. University of Colorado Boulder

An application was filed to take place at the Loveland Museum Gallery, taking place on: November 15th, 2018 from 4:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The premises was posted with a public notice, as the law requires.

NEW LICENSE

A. Kum & Go, LC d/b/a Kum & Go #994
4330 Clydesdale Parkway

The application was filed for a new 3.2% Beer Off-Premises License. The neighborhood boundaries were designated as: North – Earhart Rd.; South – County Rd 24.; East – County Rd 3; and West – Rocky Mountain Ave. The premises was posted with a sign advertising the Public Hearing and a notice was published in the Reporter Herald as the law requires.


