The Authority denied the application due to the applicant's untruthfulness of the 'DR 8404-I' Individual History Record, the background and history check. Mr. Ruiz was given opportunities to correct the form regarding his background check and he has omitted the answer entirely.

MODIFICATION OF PREMISES


