Items Related to the Delivery Pulse Services

DESCRIPTION:

Staff seeks direction and points of discussion which will lead to the creation of recommendations in the development of Code Changes for Items related to the Delivery of Pulse Services.

SUMMARY:

As work continues to develop the required City Code revisions to accommodate the addition of telecommunications services, Pulse staff is seeking policy guidance from the LCAB members with regard to Net Neutrality. Net Neutrality relates to the treatment of content, platforms, websites, and applications from different sources. Loveland has several options on this topic and seeks to have an open discussion of the direction and recommendation from LCAB for our community.

Items discussed today will be presented for recommendation with other code changes related to the delivery of Pulse services at a later meeting. At a high level, these items include the integration of communications services into Utility Billing functions (payment for services, shutoff, and delinquent payment procedures, violations of Code provisions, etc.), necessary taxes and fees, and rights to access and inspect the equipment. These revisions, clarifications, and additions are necessary for the City to accommodate the addition of telecommunications services to provide service to our community.

Staff seeks guidance in development of policy related to Net Neutrality for Pulse.

DESCRIPTION:

This item will provide an update on the Intergovernmental Agreement with Fort Collins and Estes Park for a regional shared call center and network operations.

SUMMARY:

A principal of the business model approved by City Council was to look for regional partnerships and ways to share resources with our neighboring cities that are also launching and offering broadband services to their communities. Pulse has already executed an IGA with Fort Collins (and Estes Park through a second IGA with Fort Collins) for regional sharing of long haul access and transport. The communities have also been continuing the conversation around shared call center support and shared network operations staff to increase coverage and depth. Staff will provide a high level update of the progress being made in this area.

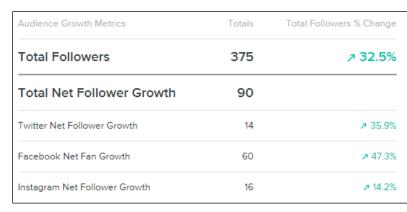
