ORDINANCE NO. 6430

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.16 AND CHAPTER 18.09 OF THE LOVELAND MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE CITY'S STORM DRAINAGE CRITERIA AND STORM DRAINAGE STANDARDS

WHEREAS, for the sake of public health, welfare, and safety the City of Loveland ("City") has adopted stormwater drainage criteria for all facilities in the City, whether public or private; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to update those criteria to reflect updates in various stormwater criteria that the City has adopted by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such amendments are in the best interest of the City and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELAND, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. That subsection 13.18.100 of the Loveland Municipal Code shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

13.18.100 - Storm drainage criteria and storm drainage standards.

All stormwater facilities that are to become part of or be connected with the city's stormwater utility shall be designed, constructed, and connected in accordance with the "City of Loveland Storm Drainage Criteria" and the "City of Loveland Storm Drainage Standards." See Title 18 of the City Code for further detail.

<u>Section 2</u>. That subsection 18.09.04.01(A) of the Loveland Municipal Code shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

18.09.04.01 Storm Drainage Criteria and Storm Drainage Standards – Adopted

A. Storm Drainage Criteria Adopted.

- 1. The "City of Loveland Storm Drainage Criteria," (hereinafter, the "Stormwater Criteria"), are adopted by reference. The Stormwater Criteria consist of:
 - a. The Denver, Colorado Mile High Flood District's "Urban Storm Drainage Criteria Manual," Volume 1 (January 2016), Volume 2 (January 2016), and Volume 3, Best Management Practices (November 2010); and

- b. The City of Loveland "Addendum to the Urban Storm Drainage Criteria Manuals Volumes 1, 2, and 3 (July 31, 2020)."
- 2. All stormwater facilities, whether public or private, shall be designed in accordance with the Stormwater Criteria.

<u>Section 3</u>. That as provided in City Charter Section 4-9(a)(7), this Ordinance shall be published by title only by the City Clerk after adoption on second reading unless the Ordinance has been amended since first reading in which case the Ordinance shall be published in full or the amendments shall be published in full. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its final publication, as provided in City Charter Section 4-8(b).
