Smoke detectors shall be installed as per R314.2.2 Alterations, repairs and additions.

Where alterations, repairs or additions requiring a permit occur, the individual dwelling unit shall be equipped with smoke alarms located as required for new dwellings.

Exceptions:

 Work involving the exterior surfaces of dwellings, such as the replacement of roofing or siding, the addition or replacement of windows or doors, or the addition of a porch or deck.

2.Installation, alteration or repairs of plumbing or mechanical systems.

Carbon monoxide detectors shall be installed per Colorado state law HB1091 revised statutes article 45

Carbon monoxide shall be installed where alterations, repairs or additions requiring a permit occur, the individual dwelling unit shall be equipped with carbon monoxide alarms located as required for new dwellings except, where Installation, alteration or repairs of mechanical systems are not fuel fired. Carbon monoxide alarms in dwelling units shall be installed outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms. Where a fuel-burning appliance is located within a bedroom or its attached bathroom, a carbon monoxide alarm shall be installed within the bedroom. The alarm devices shall be interconnected in such a manner that the actuation of one alarm will activate all of the alarms in the individual dwelling unit. Physical interconnection of carbon monoxide alarms shall not be required where listed wireless alarms are installed and all alarms sound upon activation of one alarm. Carbon monoxide alarms installed in accordance with Section R315.2.2 shall be permitted to be battery powered.
