Non-Residential and Multi-Unit Dwelling New Construction Building Permit Submittal Checklist

Please read the Submittal Instructions prior to completing this checklist.

All building permit applications for new Non-Residential and Multi-Unit Dwelling construction requires a site development plan application to be submitted to the Current Planning Division for review and approval (along with an associated Site Work Permit). This must be done prior to building permit submittal. Concurrent site development plan and building permit application reviews may be possible, if approved by the City's Development Review Team (speak with your planner about this process).

Partial build outs of new core and shell buildings or additions will not be permitted. A separate permit will be required for tenant finishes.

	 Completed and signed permit application. -Please note that contractors and valuations <u>DO NOT</u> need to be provided at time of submittal, but are required before the permit can be approved. List total square footage for <u>EACH</u> occupancy type. If property is located in the Fort Collins Loveland Water District or Little Thompson Water District, a water tap receipt will need to be submitted before the permit can be approved. For new builds that will have <u>more than one</u> tenant space, a core and shell permit will be required followed by <u>SEPARATE</u> tenant finish permits for each tenant space. Provide copy of approved early building permit authorizationform, if applicable.
