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FACILITY REQUESTS

Staff Liaison McClure updated the commission on the 5 year plan for HUD, which will consider use of CDBG funds for public facilities. In the event an agency applies for a grant for a public facility a subcommittee made up of two commissioners from each commission will convene to review the requests and send a recommendation to the Affordable Housing Commission. The sub-committee would be a sharing of information and knowledge. A motion to convene a subcommittee upon receiving applications for public facilities was made by Commissioner Greene and seconded by Commissioner Carroll and passing unanimously.
