
MADISON AVENUE CORRIDOR I PROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Loveland Public Works Department is working to transform Madison Avenue into a multimodal corridor – aimed at improving and expanding transportation and safety for all users.




PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Madison Avenue Corridor Improvements Project was originally identified in the City's Transportation Master Plan, which was adopted in 2000.

The recent completion of E. 37th Street bridge across Dry Creek links Madison Avenue and Taft Avenue with access to US Highway 287.

Existing storm-water pipes, domestic water pipes gas lines, and overhead power lines within the corridor have reached their useful life span; they will be replaced as part of this project.
