LOVELAND POLICE MAKE ARREST IN DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE ON NEW YEAR'S EVE

LOVELAND – Loveland Police Department responded to a shooting, resulting in the arrest of a 57-year old female.

On Saturday, December 31, 2022, shortly before 11:00 p.m., officers responded to the 1100 block of E. 7th Street for a domestic disturbance involving a firearm that was discharged.

Officers responded to the scene, locating two involved parties.

Officers determined the female suspect discharged a firearm at the male, not striking him. The male was treated on scene for un-related minor injuries and released.

The 57-year old female suspect was taken into custody without incident and booked for the following charges:

- Attempted 1st Degree Murder
- Felony Menacing
- Prohibited Use of a Weapon
- Domestic Violence Sentence Enhancer

This incident remains on-going.
