### UPDATE: LOVELAND POLICE ASKING FOR THE COMMUNITY'S HELP

**LOVELAND**— The Loveland Police Department is asking for the community's assistance in any information that will lead to an arrest of those involved in Friday night's homicide near 2500 E. 1<sup>st</sup> St.

Loveland Police want the public to know they are still looking for the suspect(s) and the suspect vehicle involved in a shooting that left an 18-year-old dead and a 16-year-old shot and hospitalized. The vehicle is described as: a **White Dodge Ram Pickup | Years: 2009 – 2014 | 4-Doors | Black Bedliner**

Police are asking businesses or residents with any type of camera surveillance within the following boundaries:

- East Eisenhower (US 34) to 1<sup>st</sup> St.
  - Hwy 287 to Boyd Lake Rd

Please check any Ring camera or video surveillance during the timeframe of:

- **Friday | January 20<sup>th</sup> 10:00 p.m. - Saturday | January 21<sup>st</sup> 3:00 a.m.**

Police are looking for any white pickups matching the description above and/or any person(s) walking or running, acting out of the ordinary and/or suspicious.

It is believed that at least three suspects were involved, two being young males. All suspects involved are considered armed and dangerous. If anyone comes across what may appear to be the vehicle or has knowledge of this crime, they are asked to contact 911 immediately and do not approach.

### UPDATE: LOVELAND POLICE HOMICIDE

**LOVELAND**– The Loveland Police Department is updating with additional details concerning last night’s homicide.

Preliminary investigation indicates there are at least three suspects involved; two are described as young males. After the victim was shot, the two male suspects got into the victim’s vehicle, leaving the scene through the apartment complex, following the white Dodge Ram pickup.

As the suspects entered the East side of the complex, the vehicle slid into a second vehicle, occupied by the 16-year-old victim. A verbal altercation ensued, with the 16-year-year old being shot. The two male suspects got back into the white Dodge Ram pickup and fled the scene.

The 16-year-old victim was transported for medical treatment where he remains in stable condition.

The Loveland Police Department is pursuing every lead with the utmost priority and diligence. We are grateful for the community’s assistance and tips. “In my experience, it is only through the robust partnership with the community that can help solve this heinous crime quickly.”

### LOVELAND POLICE INVESTIGATING A SHOOTING

**LOVELAND** – Loveland Police are investigating a shooting that left one dead and one injured.

On Friday, January 20, 2023, shortly after 10:15 p.m., officers responded to the Brookstone Apartment Complex in the area of 2500 E. 1<sup>st</sup> St. for a weapons complaint, multiple shots fired.

Officers arrived locating one 18-year-old male in the parking lot. Fire and medics on scene declared the male deceased. A second victim, a 16-year-old male, was in the same apartment complex on the East side of the complex suffering from a gunshot wound. He was transported for medical treatment.

Detectives, in cooperation with the Larimer County District Attorney's Office, are currently investigating.

The Larimer County Coroner's Office will identify the victim.

Detectives are asking for the public's help seeking information regarding a possible suspect vehicle, identified as a white Dodge Ram pick-up with tinted windows.
