Death Investigation

On April 13, 2023, at 4:51p.m., the Loveland Police Dispatch center received a report of an unconscious person lying face down on the sidewalk south of the restrooms on the grounds of the Barnes Park Softball Complex located at 405 South Lincoln Avenue in Loveland.

Officers along with medical personnel responded and discovered the body of an adult female. The female was pronounced deceased at the scene. Detectives and crime scene personnel were also dispatched. Several individuals in the area were interviewed and the scene was processed. There appeared to be no visible trauma to the deceased and no immediate signs of foul play. Based on observations at the scene and interviews from witnesses there appears to be no threat to the general public.

The Larimer County Coroner's Office responded and took possession of the deceased. The Coroner's Office will confirm the identity of the deceased and determine the manner and cause of death at a later time.
