Loveland, CO- From Friday, April 21, 2023, through May 5, 2023, Loveland Police Department will have information posted on their website regarding the release of a Sexually Violent Predator into the community. The following information is being released pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 16-13-901 through 16-13-905, which directs a supervising Criminal Justice Agency to inform the local law enforcement agency of a sexually violent predator's arrival in their community.

Larry G. Seabolt, born 08/22/1968, is now living in Loveland with a reported address of the Loveland Resource Center, 137 South Lincoln Ave, Loveland, Colorado 80537.

The individual subject of this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires law enforcement registration, further, they have been determined to present a high potential to re-offend and are subject to community notification regarding their residence in the community.

Sexually Violent Predators are required by law to register with law enforcement four times a year for their entire life. Loveland Police Department has no legal authority to direct where a sex offender may live. Unless court restrictions exist, they are free to live wherever they choose.
