ORDINANCE NO. <u>6607</u>

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING 1404 AND 1410 NORTH GARFIELD AVENUE IN LOVELAND, COLORADO AS A HISTORIC DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Chapter 15.56 of the Loveland Municipal Code provides that the City Council may designate a historic district, which is a geographically definable area including a concentration, linkage, or continuity of subsurface or surface sites, buildings, structures, and/or objects. having a special historical or architectural value; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.56.100(B) of the Loveland Municipal Code further provides that structures must be at least fifty (50) years old and meet one (1) or more of the criteria for architectural, social/cultural, or geographic/environmental significance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Loveland has, through the Historic Preservation Commission, worked to evaluate the nomination of the McNary-Chalfant House located at 1404 N. Garfield Ave. and the Kelley-Coffman House located at 1410 N. Garfield Ave. now hereby known collectively as the McNary-Chalfant & Kelly-Coffman Historic District; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission has recommended that the City Council designate the McNary-Chalfant & Kelley-Coffman Historic District as a historical district consistent with Chapter 15.56 of the Loveland Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing has been held on the proposed historic district designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOVELAND, COLORADO THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council finds that the McNary-Chalfant & Kelley-Coffman Historic District, more particularly described on **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B**, attached hereto and incorporated herein, satisfies the age requirement and meets the following significant criteria for designation as a historical district:

B. Social/Cultural

- a. Is a site of an historic event that had an effect upon society.
- b. Exemplifies the cultural, political, economic, or social heritage of the community.
- c. Is associated with the notable person(s) or the work of a notable person(s).

C. Geographical/Environmental

- a. Enhances sense of identity of the community.
- b. As an established in familiar natural setting or visual feature of the community.

- <u>Section 2</u>. Specifically, the McNary-Chalfant & Kelley-Coffman Historic District meet the criteria listed in Section 1 as follows: The site was the home of some of the earliest American settlers and part of the cherry orchards in the City of Loveland area, and the structures on the site provide geographical context of what occurred during the cherry orchard industry and the beginnings of suburban development in the area.
- <u>Section 3.</u> McNary-Chalfant & Kelley-Coffman Historic District, described in **Exhibit A** and depicted in **Exhibit B**, is hereby designated as a historic district consistent with Chapter 15.56 of the Loveland Municipal Code.
- <u>Section 4</u>. That copies of this Ordinance shall be kept on file with the Loveland City Clerk and are open to public inspection.
- Section 5. That as provided in City Charter Section 4-9(a)(7), this Ordinance shall be published by title only by the City Clerk after adoption on second reading unless the Ordinance has been amended since first reading in which case the Ordinance shall be published in full or the amendments shall be published in full. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its final publication, as provided in City Charter Section 4-8(b).

<u>Section 6.</u> That the City Clerk is hereby directed to record the Ordinance with the Larimer County Clerk and Recorder after its effective date in accordance with State Statutes.
