Investigation into overnight shooting.

On May 25, 2023, at 10:25p.m., the Loveland Emergency Communication center received a 911 call from a female reporting her boyfriend had been shot. Officers responded to the 200 block of West 29th Street, Loveland, Colorado.

Officers found a 29-year-old male suffering from a gunshot wound to his upper torso. Responding officers administered emergency medical aid to the male until he was transported by Thompson Valley EMS to a local hospital. The male and the original caller were interviewed but did not provide any information pertaining to the suspect's description or the circumstances surrounding the shooting. Based on preliminary information it appears both the female and the male are transients and were occupying a tent in a field in the area. It is also believed the suspect is known to the victim. Detectives and crime scene personnel responded to process the scene and the investigation is ongoing.
