LOVELAND POLICE INVESTIGATING SHOOTING

LOVELAND— The Loveland Police Department is investigating a shooting that occurred on **Wednesday, June 14, 2023**. Police were called to McKee Medical Center for a report of two victims suffering from gunshot wounds.

Further investigation revealed that two groups, in two separate vehicles, got into a disturbance at the McDonald's, 209th St. in Loveland at approximately 8:10 p.m. One vehicle involved was described as a White Nissan Altima. The second vehicle was a black Chevrolet Cruze. Both vehicles left the McDonald's lot heading North on N. Garfield, then East toward Lincoln Court, where occupant(s) of the white Nissan Altima shot at the occupants of the black Chevrolet Cruze striking two of the victims.

The gunshot victims, both 19-years old, were taken to McKee Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries. They both were treated for those injuries and released.

Loveland Police Criminal Investigations Division have arrested one of the occupants of the white Nissan in connection with the shooting.

Suspect 1, Male 16, Loveland, Colorado. Arrested: Thursday, June 15, 2023.

Count 1-4:	Criminal Attempt to Commit Murder in the First Degree, Felony 2
Count 5-6	Assault in the First Degree, Felony 3
Count 7:	Illegal Possession of a Handgun by a Juvenile, Class II Misdemeanor
