Loveland Police Investigate Fatal Motorcycle Collision

On September 16, 2023, at 10:00 p.m., the Loveland Police Dispatch Center received a report of a collision between a motorcycle and a motor vehicle at the intersection of South Taft Avenue and Carlisle Drive. When officers arrived on scene, several bystanders were present, one of which had started performing CPR on a 19-year-old male who was identified as the driver of the motorcycle. The 41-year-old female of the other involved motor vehicle remained on scene and was cooperative with the police. The preliminary investigation indicates the motorcycle was traveling southbound on South Taft Avenue and struck the rear passenger quarter panel of the motor vehicle as it was turning west onto Carlisle Drive. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to a local hospital where he was later pronounced deceased. There were no injuries to the occupants of the motor vehicle.
