_____ This mountain park features the Exploration Zone which uses natural materials to create a play area.

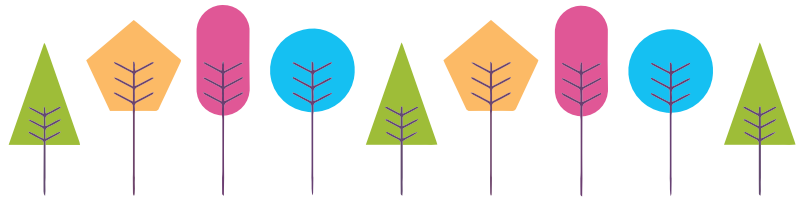
_____ Locals often call this cannon park, but what's its real name?
