_____ This snowy white owl sticks out amongst the bronze statues and greenery.

_____ Elmo, Carlton and MercyMe have made this fun, celebratory movement popular – show us your best moves!

_____ This fool was historically an entertainer during the medieval and Renaissance eras with a wide variety of skills like song, music & storytelling, acrobatics, juggling, telling jokes and magic tricks.

_____ Ring-around-the-rosies, a pocket full of posies...help make this circle whole by joining hands.

_____ This yoga pose will help you blend in at the park.

_____ A large water bird with a long beak and a large throat pouch used for catching fish & draining water before swallowing.

_____ In the Old West, women worked side by side with men and rode horses to perform related tasks. This statue shows the protective garment used when riding a horse through brushy terrain.

_____ Origami-shaped horses in bright colors make this statue easy to find.

_____ Pull on this and make a wish, but only if you get the bigger half!

_____ This sentinel is keeping the park safe from anyone coming from the north.
