PRIVATE PROPERTY



Trespassing on Private Property

Trespassing must be reported by property owners or their agents to the Loveland Police Department's non-emergency phone number: 970-667-2151.



Code Violations on Private Property

Accumulation of trash or unsanitary conditions should be reported to the City of Loveland's Code Administration team. Call 970-962-2506 or visit lovgov.org/CodeAdministration.



PUBLIC PROPERTY



Encampments on Public Property

Encampments located on public property should be reported to the appropriate municipality or agency responsible for that area.

Outside of City Limits

Within City Limits

Report the encampment to the City of Loveland by phone to the Homeless Hotline at 970-962-2150 or visit lovgov.org/homelessness.
