CALL TO ORDER

Chair Thompson called the meeting to order at 5:20 pm.

APPROVAL OF JANUARY MEETING MINUTES

Commissioner V. Ealey made a motion to approve the January 13th meeting minutes. Commissioner Weeden-Osborn seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Carol Rush with the League of Women Voters informed the commission that Bryce Hach with Homeward 2020 and Glorie Magrum with House of Neighborly Service will present information on the Road Home Program and 137 Homeless Connect at the Coloradoan on Monday April 11th.

CITY COUNCIL LIAISON UPDATE

Councilor Johnson sent an email to staff that stated that the City Council has set poverty and homelessness as a forefront issue for city staff to work on.

ZOOM GRANTS TRAINING

The president of ZoomGrants, Geoff Hamilton, showed the commissioners how to access proposals, documents, and input their scores.

2011 GRANT DISCUSSION

Staff handed out grant guides. One proposal has been received for a Public Facilities grant. The commission will have two members meet with two members from the Human Services Commission to

1 discuss the agency and the aspects of the project in relevance to the community. This committee will
2 report back to the rest of the AHC, since this proposal will be reviewed by them along with the other CDBG
3 proposals. Commissioners Jessen and C. Ealey volunteered to be on the committee.

6 This annual summit will be on March 2nd at 5:00. Two commissioners volunteered to attend, Commissioner
7 Jessen and V. Ealey. Staff Hade and the commission reviewed the goals and accomplishments from 2010
8 and updated them for 2011. The main addition to the goals is to review the Affordable Housing code
9 amendment and present recommendations to City Council. Staff Hade will update the housing stats for
10 2010 regarding the impact of CDBG on Loveland. This will be used to show HUD and senators, not just the
11 financial benefit, but the number of people it has helped. Commissioners, let staff know if you have ideas
12 of additional stats that could be used.
