- 2 report back to the rest of the AHC, since this proposal will be reviewed by them along with the other CDBG

- 10 2010 regarding the impact of CDBG on Loveland. This will be used to show HUD and senators, not just the
- 11 financial benefit, but the number of people it has helped. Commissioners, let staff know if you have ideas
- 12 of additional stats that could be used.
